Does Women's Wrestling have an advantage over other sports that do not have a corresponding NCAA male championships? Are Women's Sports without an equivalent Men's Championship growing like other women's sports?

MatStats believes that Women's Wrestling has a huge advantage in long term growth over sports without a male championship equivalent. The 4 biggest women's sports without a male counterpart grow at **12%** compared to the **123%** growth for the top 14 sports. 4 of the 5 slowest growing women's sports do NOT have a male counterpart.

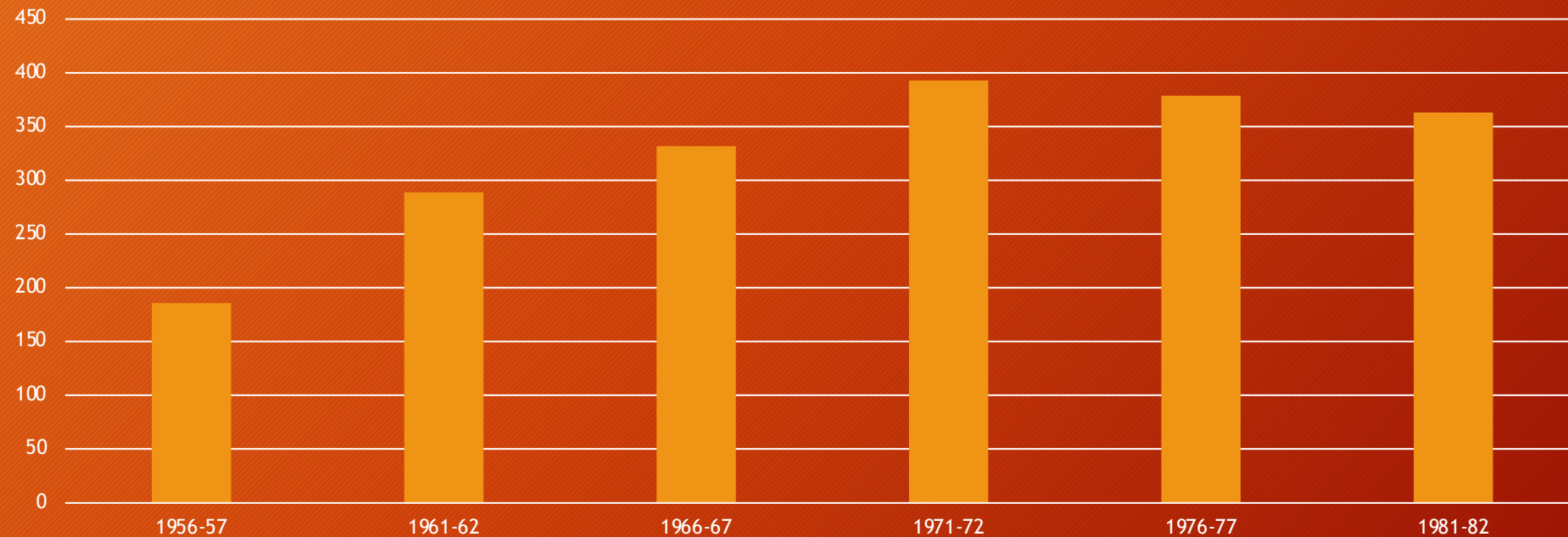

- Wrestling was the only one of the top 14 men's sports to decrease the number of teams from 1982 to 2022.
- The advent of women's wrestling resulted in the recent growth of NCAA men's wrestling teams.
 - Title IX did NOT "destroy" the number of Men's NCAA teams.
- MatStats is saying that there easily could be a day where there are more NCAA Women's teams than Men's.
 - The growth of Women's Wrestling will aid the continued growth of Men's teams.
 - There is no problem if they both continue to grow.
- NCAA Wrestling Championship could capitalize on being the only sport that has the Men's & Women's Championships at the same venue, the same time, next to each other.
 - The NAIA should mimic the NCAA with their growth and Championships.
