Do all players across all team sports have equal value for winning championships?

All Sports Have Players Adding Equal Value, Some are More Equal Than Others.

- Football has 22 players on the field at the same time.
- Football has 3 different units - Offense, Defense, Special Teams.
- So, one player most likely plays less than half the plays each year.
- Hockey has at most 12 on the ice at one time (Penalties can reduce this).
- Basketball has 10 on the court at once.
- Baseball has between 10-13 on the field at once. 9 in the field, 1 at the plate, and between 0 and 3 on base.
- Hockey has different shifts, so no one except the goalie plays all 60 minutes.
- Basketball also rotates. Except Wilt Chamberlain. The Dipper never fouled out and in 1961-62, he averaged 48.5 minutes/game. Overtimes allowed him to play more than 48/game.
- Pitchers rotate and only Gehrig and Ripken played everyday for long periods of time.

Which of the 4 biggest team sports in America does an individual have the smallest chance to add value?

There is Less Room in Football for an Individual Player to Add Value.

- The only great players in Basketball, Hockey, and Baseball that do NOT play more than half the plays/minutes/innings are the Pitchers.
- In Football most players do not play half the plays, if they do it is not substantially more than 50%.
- They can play more than half based on time of possession either on O or D.
- Football has the most players on the field by far.
- Yet for some reason the first argument used in most debates about who was the greatest football player ever is “He won the most rings”.
- But this only holds true for Brady. No one says (except his Mom) there were only two players were better than kicker Adam Vinatieri.

- It would be blasphemous to suggest that there have been 56 NCAA Men's D1 wrestlers better than Gable. MatStats would need to do voluminous research to rank the individuals.
